This vessel has a classic-ship profile and cuts an attractive figure in the water. Built to handle the outdoors -- and the often-wet weather of the tropics -- most cabins are accessed via the open decks that run along the sides of the three upper decks.



There are no balconies, as passengers (except those on D Deck) step straight out of their staterooms or suites onto these three-foot wide decks and take in the glorious views.

The small ship, with its handful of public rooms, provides the perfect blend of bonhomie and intimacy. Passengers easily find little nooks to sit alone and read books or snooze. As most water sports take place off the ship, the pool goes unused for long periods (except when there are children onboard), and there are always plenty of loungers available. The ship can carry up to 130 passengers.

Every cabin type features a private bathroom ensuite, internal telephone, on/off air-conditioning, hair dryer, 240 volt power, international shaver point, soaps, shampoo & towels serviced daily. Each cabin is approximately 14sqm. Tabua Suites are approximately 28sqm. Staterooms and Suites open onto the outside deck and have two windows.


Tabua Suites (4) feature a bedroom (twin/double) with ensuite bathroom, plus a separate day room with, chair, settee, desk, TV & DVD player, refrigerator, tea & coffee facilities and second bathroom.

Connecting Family Staterooms (4) are located on the upper or main decks (twin/double).


Staterooms (36) are located on the main decks (twin/double).

Cabins (11) with portholes, open onto an inside passageway (twin/double/bunk triple/bunk quad).




